- Nomination deadline: **10 May** for the 2021 fall semester and **10 November** for the 2022 spring semester.

- English language requirement is minimum B2 level.
- Courses each worth **5 credits**. Length of the courses is 12 weeks x 90 minutes of classes. Some courses are concentrated over several days as block seminars.
- Courses available in ENGLISH, GERMAN, FRENCH and ITALIAN languages (majority in English) in various fields of LAW, CRIMINOLOGY AND POLITICAL SCIENCE
- All 9 faculties' ERASMUS courses are open for all ERASMUS students of any faculty
- Free Hungarian language courses for ERASMUS students
