Notes on the application documents and the admission procedure:

- **Deadline for submission of the application for admission and related documents is January 15, 2026.**
- An Admission has provisional status until all documents have been submitted to the Dean's Office of the Faculty of Chemistry as originals or certified copies. Documents submitted late will result in final exclusion from the admission procedure.
- The following deadlines apply: Proof of sufficient German or English language skills can be submitted until May 15, 2026. Certificates of graduation can be submitted until September 30, 2026.
- If you are already studying or have studied in a closely related degree program, an examination is required to determine whether you are still eligible for admission to the Göttingen Master's Program in Chemistry.
- If the university does not provide ECTS information, please send us module descriptions of the modules you have taken, including information on the number of hours you have spent studying (self-study and attendance study).
- Language certificates: Please note that we can only accept the types of evidence specified in the Regulations on Access and Admission to the Program.
- eAssessment as supplementary proof of the relevance of previous studies: In addition to the submission of other documents, the following groups of persons must provide proof of their previous studies:
 - by foreign nationals and stateless persons with a recognized prior education certificate who are neither equivalent to Germans under legal regulations nor nationals of another member state of the European Union or another contracting state to the Agreement on the European Economic Area, nor have acquired their Bachelor's degree or an equivalent degree at a German higher education institution or at a higher education institution of another member state of the European Union or another contracting state to the Agreement on the European Economic Area.

The eAssessment will be carried out from 01.01.2026 to 28.02.2026. After submitting your application documents, you will receive the necessary access data from us as soon as the assessment period starts.
